 Wetpour issues Piper Hill RTC Safety Surfaces were currently too busy to visit for a quote. The **dog bin on the corner of Horseshoe Close** is broken and in need of replacing. Cllrs discussed and it was agreed that a quote for a new dog bin be sourced from Street Scene. Dep Clerk to action.

It was noted that the **first tree on the Land Trust strip** from the Business Park to Colburn Lane roundabout is in a poor condition and may need removing. Office to contact Ian Kendall from the Land Trust for inspection. Groundsman is removing some of the lower branches so that the mower can run underneath.

SC Electrics have been out and work is needed to the ground switch to the lamp post on The Broadway. **Office to contact S C Electrics for quote**.

The **metal netting in the goal in Albermarle play park** needs repair work and a new powder coat. Repairs can be done by Cllrs, Groundsman will obtain 3 quotes from companies for the powder coating.

Clir Burnham reported that he had noticed 2 of the litter bins knocked over along Forest

Drive. Street scene to be contacted to see if we can secure the bins in place.

A kind resident has been making **bird boxes for our Sidings woods**. A thank you will be put on face book and our website.

Barry reported that **dog faeces were again found in the Muga**. The committee agreed that signs needed to be purchased. 2 x A3 signs for the long sides and one A4 for the gate were required, Cllrs Towers sourced a sign company and the office will order.

Groundsman reported that a resident at **Albermarle Play Park** is propping his fence up with some pieces of wood with nails in. Office to contact resident to remove this.
